Interior Painting Planning

- Assess wall condition before painting. Look for drywall damage or nail holes that require patching.
- Test colour samples under different lighting conditions before committing to a full room.
- Use durable finishes such as eggshell or satin for living areas and hallways.

Surface Preparation

- Wash surfaces to remove dust, grease, and contaminants that prevent adhesion.
- Light sanding improves bonding between paint layers.
- Apply primer when covering repairs or when switching between dark and light colours.
- Preparation is often the most important factor in achieving a long lasting paint job.

Exterior Painting Considerations

- Calgary climate requires paints that can tolerate rapid temperature swings.
- Proper caulking and sealing helps prevent moisture penetration.
- Different surfaces such as stucco, Hardie board, and wood siding require different preparation.
