Professional Painting Workflow

- Professionals usually paint ceilings first, then walls, and finish with trim.
- Cutting-in techniques are used to achieve clean lines between surfaces.
- Rollers provide even coverage while brushes handle corners and trim.
- Large projects sometimes use spray equipment for efficiency.

Paint Product Selection

- Acrylic latex paints dominate modern residential painting due to durability.
- Exterior paints should contain UV resistant additives.
- Higher quality paints often reduce the need for multiple coats.

Maintenance and Longevity

- Regular cleaning of painted surfaces helps maintain appearance.
